Saturday, January 28, 10 am and 1 pm

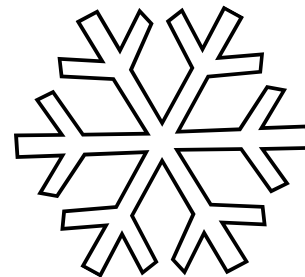
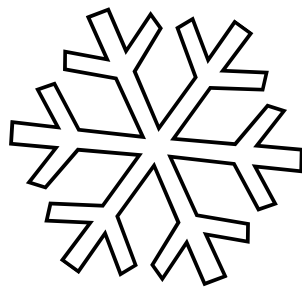
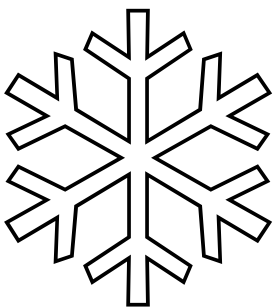
