CLASSROOM RENTAL INFORMATION

The Farm Center is offering the classroom, which is attached to the main barn, for rental. The classroom can seat approximately 60+ people and it is wheelchair accessible. Since the classroom is attached to the barn, your group will experience all the sounds and smells of a farm. Tables and chairs are available for your group, but it is your responsibility to set them up and arrange them to your liking. There are 14 tables-18"x72"/6 feet long, 10 tables-30"x72"/6 feet long and 100 chairs available. Please specify the number of tables & chairs your group requires in advance. The classroom also offers a small kitchen with refrigerator. **Be prepared to carry your items from the parking lot to the classroom, the classroom is approximately 250 ft from parking lot. Vehicles are not permitted to drive up to the barn. We suggest bringing a wagon or dolly to transport your items.** Restrooms are not attached to the classroom. They are located at the Farm Office, which is the building next to the barn. Children **MUST** be accompanied by appropriate adult supervision.

Rates/Availability: Day rate - \$25 per hour between the hours of 9am and 5pm (2 hour minimum); evening rate - \$50 per hour for the 1st 2 hours between the hours of 5pm and 10pm, \$35 each additional hour after the 1st 2 hours (2 hour minimum).

Reservations are required a minimum of ten (10) days in advance.



Kosch Catering is the exclusive catering company for Kensington Metropark. All groups that have their event catered must use Kosch Catering; no other food service companies will be permitted in the park. If you choose not to have your event catered, you are welcome to bring in your own food. Please refrain from attaching any decorations to the walls of the classroom. You may decorate the tables and chairs, but it is your responsibility to clean up the area when you have finished for the day. Set up and clean up are included within the time frame you have reserved. If you require additional set up/clean up time you must reserve an additional block of time. The reserving individual will be held financially responsible for damage to the classroom beyond normal wear and tear.

Public hayrides are offered Saturdays and Sundays 12pm – 4pm, year-round weather permitting. The fare for the 20-minute ride for adults is \$5, children 3yrs - 12yrs & seniors 62yrs and over is \$3, and children 2yrs and under are free. No reservations for public rides. Private charters are available on select days by advance reservation only. Hayrides are not included in the reservation fee for the classroom, they are an additional cost. Cancellations: Groups may cancel for any reason with a 24-hour notice. If there is a cancellation and a refund is granted, processing will take approximately 4-6 weeks. Or your group may reschedule to another available date within the calendar year, with a 24-hour notice.

PARK ENTRY FEES ARE NOT INCLUDED IN THE RESERVATION FEE. A fee of \$5 per vehicle on the weekdays, weekends and holidays, or \$25 per vehicle for an annual sticker (\$15 for a senior annual) is required on all vehicles entering the park and may be obtained at the tollbooths or Park Office. Group billing is available on a limited basis. Please contact the Park Office for more information.
