An interpreter will lead the group on a visit through the sugarbush area with stops to see the working evaporator in the sugar shack, learning how to identify maple trees, tapping a tree and/or sap collection, and a stop at a native american sugaring camp. Also new, the camp will have re-enactors representing Michigan natives of the 18th century, showing and answering questions about life in an Algonquin winter camp.
