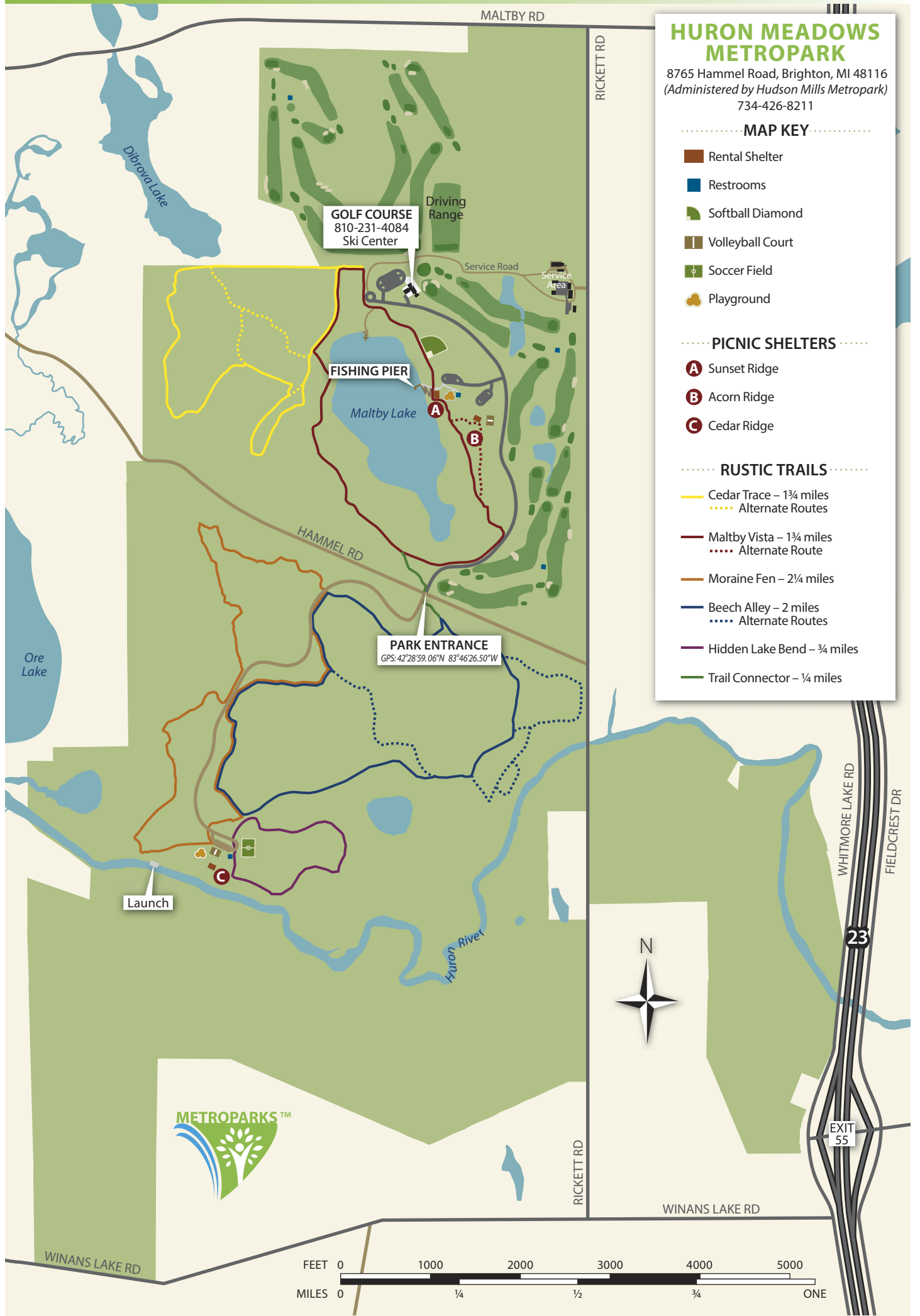

## ACTIVITIES



### BOATING

Canoes and kayaks are welcome on Maltby lake. No gasoline motors are allowed.

### CONCESSIONS

Food and beverages, including beer, wine, and liquor are sold at the Golf Starter Building. No outside alcoholic beverages or coolers allowed.

### FISHING

Fishing is available along the Huron River or Maltby Lake. A barrier-free fishing pier is located at the Sunset Ridge picnic area on Maltby Lake. A Michigan Fishing license is required.

### GOLF

810-231-4084

This 6,663 yard, 18-hole, par-72 course, and driving range offers power carts, pull carts, and clubs for rent. Senior (55+) and junior (20 and younger) rates are available. Some restrictions apply.

### RUSTIC TRAILS

There are approximately five miles of trails that lead hikers through fields and woodlands. Access the trail south of Hammel Road at Cedar Ridge picnic area. You can access to the trail around Maltby Lake at Sunset Ridge and Acorn Ridge picnic areas.

### PETS

Dogs and other pets are permitted in the park only when kept on a six foot (or less) leash. Pets are not permitted in buildings, on the cross country ski trails, or the golf course.

### PICNICS

Tables, grills, and shelters are located throughout the park. Please register with the Park Office if you have a group of 50 people or more. Shelters can be reserved for a fee.

### PLAYGROUNDS

A large playground is located in the Sunset Ridge picnic area. Swings and a slide can be found in the Cedar Ridge picnic area.

### WINTER SPORTS

#### CROSS-COUNTRY SKIING

Enjoy miles of marked trails groomed for both classical and skate-skiing. The Ski Center (Golf Starter Building) is open daily when conditions permit for ski rentals, and features a heated lounge, restrooms, and snacks. Groups of ten people or more can make arrangements to rent skis during the week. The Bucks Run Trail is maintained with man-made snow throughout the winter as conditions permit and is the only trail where a usage fee is charged.

#### ICE FISHING

The lake is open to ice fishing as conditions permit. A Michigan Fishing license is required.
