That the Board of Commissioners approve the 2014 Second Quarter Budget Amendments as recommended by Controller Franchock and staff.

Background: In order to maintain compliance with 2014 Budget line item appropriation limits, monthly reviews have been made of Capital and Operation General Fund expenditure accounts. As a result of these reviews and subsequent review and approval by the Director, these appropriation adjustments have been recorded.

\$50,800 (4 percent) of the \$1,341,725 in General Fund appropriation adjustments made represent appropriations transferred between accounts within the same cost center.

\$537,625 (40 percent) of the \$1,341,725 in General Fund appropriation adjustments made represent appropriations transferred between accounts between the same cost centers.

Action Requested: Motion to Approve

That the Board of Commissioners accept the proposal from Anderson, Eckstein and Westrick, Inc. to provide engineering consulting services as outlined in their proposal dated May 28, 2014 in the amount of \$38,500 as recommended by Manager of Assets and Development Mike Brahm-Henkel and staff.

Background: In response to our request, the firm of Anderson, Eckstein and Westrick, Inc. (AEW) of Shelby Township has submitted a proposal for engineering design services, for pool discharge modifications to the Lake Erie pool and the Lake St. Clair pool. The scope of services will include the preparation of construction plans, specifications, site evaluation, evaluation of discharge flows, evaluation of current pump capacities, geotechnical testing, permit applications, and construction support services. AEW's total fee amount is \$38,500. AEW's design services will be provided on a fixed-fee basis, billed at their hourly rate. Construction service fees are estimated and will be billed based on actual services rendered. Application and review fees will be paid by AEW and reimbursed by HCMA.

The existing pool backwash systems currently discharge to a sump within the buildings, and from there to the storm sewer system. This discharge of backwash water is not in compliance with current regulations, and it must discharge to a sanitary sewer system. The existing systems must be verified as to filter backwash rate and sanitary sewer pump station discharge rate. The proposed system must be able to accept backwash discharge without overwhelming the existing sewer during backwash cycles; therefore, the system may require flow equalization. The proposed sewers must cross a number of existing underground utilities and the design must provide for avoidance of conflicts. Existing utility crossings must be exposed to verify grades/ elevations/ locations during design.

Dear Chairman LaBelle:

Lansing resembles a ghost town as the 2014 Primary Election campaigns are in full gear. The only legislators in Lansing are either term limited or participating in bill signing ceremonies with the Governor. Most legislative staffers are taking vacation time to campaign. The Governor has signed all the segments of the FY 2015-15 State Budget with vetoes of a few "special projects".

While both the House and Senate are scheduled for session on July 16th little is expected to move. There have been some attempts for the Senate to concur in the House passed transportation package but all have been unsuccessful to date. With approximately 90% of all Legislators being elected, or re-elected, in the Primary due to reapportionment most members are content to wait until fall.

We will have a more detailed analysis following the Primary Election when the lame duck session officially begins.

That the Board of Commissioners award Contract No. 2-509-14T to the low responsive, responsible bidder, DiPonio Contracting, Inc., in the amount of \$457,067.00 and transfer \$348,100.00 from the Supplement Major Maintenance Fund and transfer \$77,000.00 from Capital Fund Balance to cover the difference between the budgeted Capital amount and the proposed work order amount of \$123,000.00 as recommended by Manager of Assets and Development Mike Brahm-Henkel and staff.

Fiscal Impact: Transfer \$348,100.00 from the Supplement Major Maintenance Fund and Transfer \$77,000.00 from Capital Fund balance.

Scope of Work: This project is a combination of Supplemental Major Maintenance work and Capital Improvement. The Supplemental Major Maintenance work includes the abandonment of the existing failing force main and pump station and replaces it with approximately 2,400 linear feet of 10-inch gravity sewer to Shelby Township. The Capital Improvement project includes the construction of a sewage disposal station for the campground as required by the MDEQ. The disposal station includes aggregate and paved road construction, disposal appurtenances, and approximately 445 lineal feet of 1-inch water service supply. Work also includes furnishing all labor, equipment and materials necessary for construction.
