

Enclosed is a list of available trees for the tree donation program. These trees are locally grown and should perform well. Please note, some species may not be available at the time of the donation and an alternative selection may be required. These trees should have a 2 ½" diameter trunk.

Shade Trees:

Red Oak (*Quercus rubra*)
Sugar Maple (*Acer saccharum*)
Tulip Tree (*Liriodendron tulipifera*)
Red maple (*Acer freemanii* or *rubrum*)
Honeylocust (*Gleditsia triacanthos*)
Kentucky coffee tree (*Gymnocladus dioica*)
Bur oak (*Quercus macrocarpa*)
Hackberry (*Celtus occidentalis*)

Shade Trees Wet Soil:

Swamp white oak (*Quercus bicolor*)
American elm (*Ulmus* sp., resistant varieties, hybrids)
American basswood (*Tilia americana*)
American sycamore (*Platanus occidentalis*)
Pin oak (*Quercus palustris*)

Ornamental Understory- Smaller Trees:

Flowering dogwood (*Cornus florida*)
Red bud (*Cercis canadensis*)
River birch (*Betula nigra*)
Crabapple Varieties (*Malus* sp.)
Downy serviceberry (*Amelanchier arborea*)
Allegheny serviceberry (*Amelanchier laevis*)
Autumn brilliance serviceberry (*Amelanchier x grandiflora*)
Robin Hill serviceberry (*Amelanchier x Robin Hill*)
American hornbeam (*Carpinus caroliniana*)
American hophornbeam (*Ostrya virginiana*)
