Dear Boat Owner:

1. The annual slip rental for seasonal dockage at Kensington Metropark for the 2026 season will begin with a virtual lottery online with registration beginning Saturday, January 24th, 2026, and will continue through Thursday, February 12th, 2026. Those wishing to participate in the drawing can sign up at no cost to be eligible for this drawing at www.metroparks.com/boatlottery. Signing up for this lottery does not guarantee a slip for the 2026 season. The lottery will take place on Friday February 13th, 2026, with winners being contacted starting at 8 a.m. on Monday February 16th, 2026, to choose their boat slip. Please make sure you are available this day by phone to ensure selection goes smoothly. Attached are maps of the dockage area and park; as well as rules, which stipulate the Rules and Regulations each slip renter is responsible for adhering to. Please let us know if you should have any questions or need additional information.
2. After you have determined the size of slip necessary, enter the information on the "Boat Dockage Agreement – Kensington Metropark." It is your responsibility to be familiar with each of the three slip rental areas as to their specific location, launching ramp availability, placement of the slips and the mooring options available for your boat. You should familiarize yourself with each area in advance of the rental lottery. Kensington staff will be contacting lottery winners in order, so please be prepared to make your decision in a timely manner. After selecting a slip, you will not have an opportunity to return the slip for another.
3. All MC numbers, valid registrations and slip rental decals must be on the craft prior to launching on Kent Lake.

The following classes of slips are available:

A	78" to 96"	22'	84	\$800.00
B	66" to 72"	20'	1	\$725.00
C	54" to 65"	18'	6	\$500.00

To determine the size slip which you require, measure your boat at the widest point between the sides, which determines the beam of the craft. Take this measurement and add four-to-six inches to the beam measurement to determine what class of boat slip you will require. Please bear in mind that you must provide adequate slip protection for your boat, plus, be able to navigate in and out of the slip. This

measurement is critical; miscalculation could put your boat in an undersized category, which will require its removal from the slip.

A vehicle entry permit is required for all vehicles, including boats, as they enter the park. 2026 auto annual permits are available now and valid from the date of purchase through December 31, 2026. Instead of purchasing an annual permit for your vehicle and/or boat, you may elect to purchase a daily permit each time you enter the park; the option is yours.

We accept Visa, MasterCard, American Express and Discover. Make all checks out to H.C.M.A. (Huron-Clinton Metropolitan Authority). If you should have any questions, please feel free to contact the Park Office. Our staff hopes that you have a very enjoyable and safe boating season.

RULES PERTAINING TO THE SLIP RENTAL AGREEMENT

1. Mitten Bay dockage is for pontoon boats only. Pontoons are not permitted at the East Boat Launch.
2. The Huron-Clinton Metropolitan Authority assumes no responsibility for loss or damage to any boat or equipment. Please secure or remove equipment, including lifejackets, motors and other items when leaving the park.
3. Each renter must provide adequate bumpers and mooring lines to protect their boat plus neighboring crafts. (Mooring must be checked regularly, you will be responsible for damage to other crafts). All necessary safety gear (lifejackets, lights and fire extinguishers) required for your craft must be on board while operating on Kent Lake.
4. We reserve the right to cancel the agreement if measurements furnished are not the same as for the craft docked.
5. Park hours are 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. Renters are required to be off the lake and out of the park by 10 p.m. closing.
6. Speed limit on the lake is 10 mph. Within 100 feet of the docks, launches, or beaches the speed limit is 5 mph.
7. All boating accidents involving capsizing, damage or loss of equipment, injury to any person, drowning or asphyxiation are to be reported immediately to Park Police Officers who will file the necessary State Water Accident Report.
8. Motor vehicle permits and boat launching permits are required all year. A dockage decal must be attached to the boat on the hull in a location visible from the dock when the boat is moored. Boats with missing or improper decals will be removed at the owner's expense and slip will be re-rented.
9. The Park Office must be notified when the boat is docked and/or removed. Any change in ownership of craft docked, and any changes in owner's address or phone number, must be made known to the Park Office.
10. Picnicking is allowed on Labadie Island only. Please bring your refuse back with you.
11. Swimming is permitted at Martindale Beach and Maple Beach, Memorial Weekend through Labor Day Weekend. No swimming from your boat.
12. Boats are not permitted in marked swimming areas.
13. All crafts must display proper lights when operating between sunrise and sunset.
14. **Boats may be docked beginning May 1, 2026** (unless inadequate rainfall postpones this date; you will be notified in advance if this occurs). **Dockage decals expire October 11, 2026.** Boats must be removed on or before this date so that the water level can be lowered to the winter level (which begins October 1st, 2026). After this date, boats will be removed at the owner's expense and liability.
15. **Dockage decals will be available beginning April 16, 2026.** Dockage decals will be mailed from the Park Office to each slip holder.
16. Refunds for slips will only occur if the slip is re-rented for the season. The re-rental of a boat slip can be done by Metropark personnel only. If the slip is re-rented, the original renter will receive a refund on a pro-rated basis with a \$50 processing fee administered.
17. Any checks returned by a bank will automatically cancel the rental agreement and the slip will be forfeited. There will be a \$25 fee for all returned checks.

NOTE: Due to the prevailing wind, boats at the East Boat Launching site should be moored bow out.




