

BOATING REGULATIONS

- Metroparks boat launching permits are required for all trailered vessels entering the park.
- Speed limit on Stony Creek Lake is 10 mph.
- Boat launching must be at designated launching site. Car top boats, canoes and kayaks that can be carried to the water may be carried from any parking lot.
- No boat may be left on the lake or shoreline between 9 p.m. and 8 a.m. except by written permission obtained at the Metropark Office. Land storage area rental information is also available at the Metropark Office.
- Water skiing, tubing and wakeboarding is not permitted on any area of the lake.
- Swimming is permitted only in designated swim areas. No boats permitted in any swimming area.
- No boats permitted north of 28 Mile Road; NO MOTOR BOATS between the north dam and 28 Mile Road.
- Boats and operators must comply with all sections of Marine Safety Law: (Act 303 PA 1967) as amended and rules established by Michigan Boating Control Committee.
- Boat rental is located at Mt. Vernon Picnic Area near Baypoint Beach. Kayaks, rowboats and paddle boats are available. No rental of outboard motors.

FISHING REGULATIONS

- Fishing licenses are required of all persons past their 17th birthday and licenses are not sold at the Metropark but may be obtained at sporting goods stores.
- A license must be in possession of any person fishing.
- No fishing permitted in the nature study area north of 28 Mile Road. No fishing permitted on beaches or from bridges. No fishing at the Inwood Trails mitigation area.
- Ice shanties cannot remain on the ice overnight
- Bait, limited to worms, is available for purchase at the Boat Rental and Park Office from May through September.
